

CHARTER LEVELS

Basic Level Charter

- Minimum of 6-15 members.
- Members must be ages 14-18.
- Minimum of one advisor at least 23 years.
- Required to hold weekly meetings, elect officers, and submit their charter application.

Silver Level Charter

- Must be a current chartered Keystone Club member within current annual charter period.
- Complete a minimum of 200 service hours.
- Submit Keystone Club plans for upcoming year.
- Must plan, implement and submit experiential projects and activities in Keystone's four focus areas: Academic Success, Career Preparation, Community Service and Teen Outreach.
- Submit a Keystone National Project Report.
- Must plan and implement at least one #WeOwnFriday Teen Recruitment event.

Gold Level Charter

- Must serve as mentors to Torch Club Members.
- Complete a minimum 400 service hours.
- Must plan and implement at least two #WeOwnFriday Teen Recruitment event.
- Participate and submit a brief description on one or more of your service initiative events on the appropriate registration form. National Service Initiatives include the following:
 - Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. National Day of Service
 - Global Youth Service Day
 - United We Serve: Summer of Service
 - Worldwide Day of Play
 - The Big Help National Family Week
 - One Member One Hour Activities

Legacy Level Charter

- Must be an approved Gold Level Keystone Club Member for two consecutive years.
- Complete a minimum of 600 service hours.
- Demonstrate that they are Champions of Teens in their community by completing two or more of the following:
 - Develop an annual marketing plan.
 - Host six teen recruiting events each year.
 - Serve as a mentor and teen advocate for the club by being active participants in the community.
 - Have a formal transition program in place to advance the Torch Club.
 - Keystone Club Members have planned and implemented at least three #WeOwnFriday events.
